- **Webinar registration confirmation and WebEx join meeting links**

- When you submit your registration for a webinar you will receive a confirmation email from messenger@webex.com. Please make sure that messenger@webex is on your "safe senders" list.
- The confirmation email will contain:
 - A calendar appointment to add to your calendar
 - Instructions and a link to join the meeting.
 - A link to WebEx help if you are unable to join.

- **Joining a WebEx meeting**

- When joining the meeting for the first time, you may be prompted to install a Cisco WebEx add-on. This add-on may invoke a security warning depending upon your organizational rules.
- You may need assistance from your local IT area to resolve this message and install WebEx.

- **Providers registered before registration closes will be sent a reminder message approx. two days before the webinar.**

- The reminder email will include the same links and instructions for joining the webinar as your confirmation email.
- Within the email you will have a calendar appointment to add to your calendar, which also includes the links and instructions for joining the meeting.
